# **Readings for Sunday, January 14**

**Epistle Lesson: Verse:** Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us. Rejoice greatly in the Lord, O righteous ones.

## The reading is from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Ephesians (4:7-13)

But grace was given to each of us according to the measure of Christ's gift. Therefore, it is said, "When He ascended on high He led a host of captives, and He gave gifts to men." (In saying, "He ascended," what does it mean but that He had also descended into the lower parts of the earth? He who descended is He who also ascended far above all the heavens, that he might fill all things.) And His gifts were that some should be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.

## Gospel Lesson (Matthew 4: 12-17)

Now when he heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew into Galilee; and leaving Nazareth he went and dwelt in Capernaum by the sea, in the territory of Zebulun and Naphtali, that what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah might be fulfilled: "The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, toward the sea, across the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles—the people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, and for those who sat in the region and shadow of death light has dawned." From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

**Megalinarion (after we kneel for the consecration):** O my soul, magnify the ever virgin Maid who from the curse has redeemed us. O all spotless Bride, surpassing comprehension are the wonders of your childbirth, blessed Mother. Through you, obtaining comprehensive salvation, we bring you a gift, in striking up this worthy hymn of gratitude to you, our Benefactress.

**Communion Hymn: (Psalm 112:6)** Is mni-mo-si-non e-o-ni-on e-ste di-ke-os. Alliluia. The memory of the righteous will endure forever. Alleluia.

1. Choir

2. Altar boys

3. Sunday school teachers (who will line up in middle aisle before Communion)

4. Sunday school students (who will line up in the middle aisle before Communion behind the teachers)
